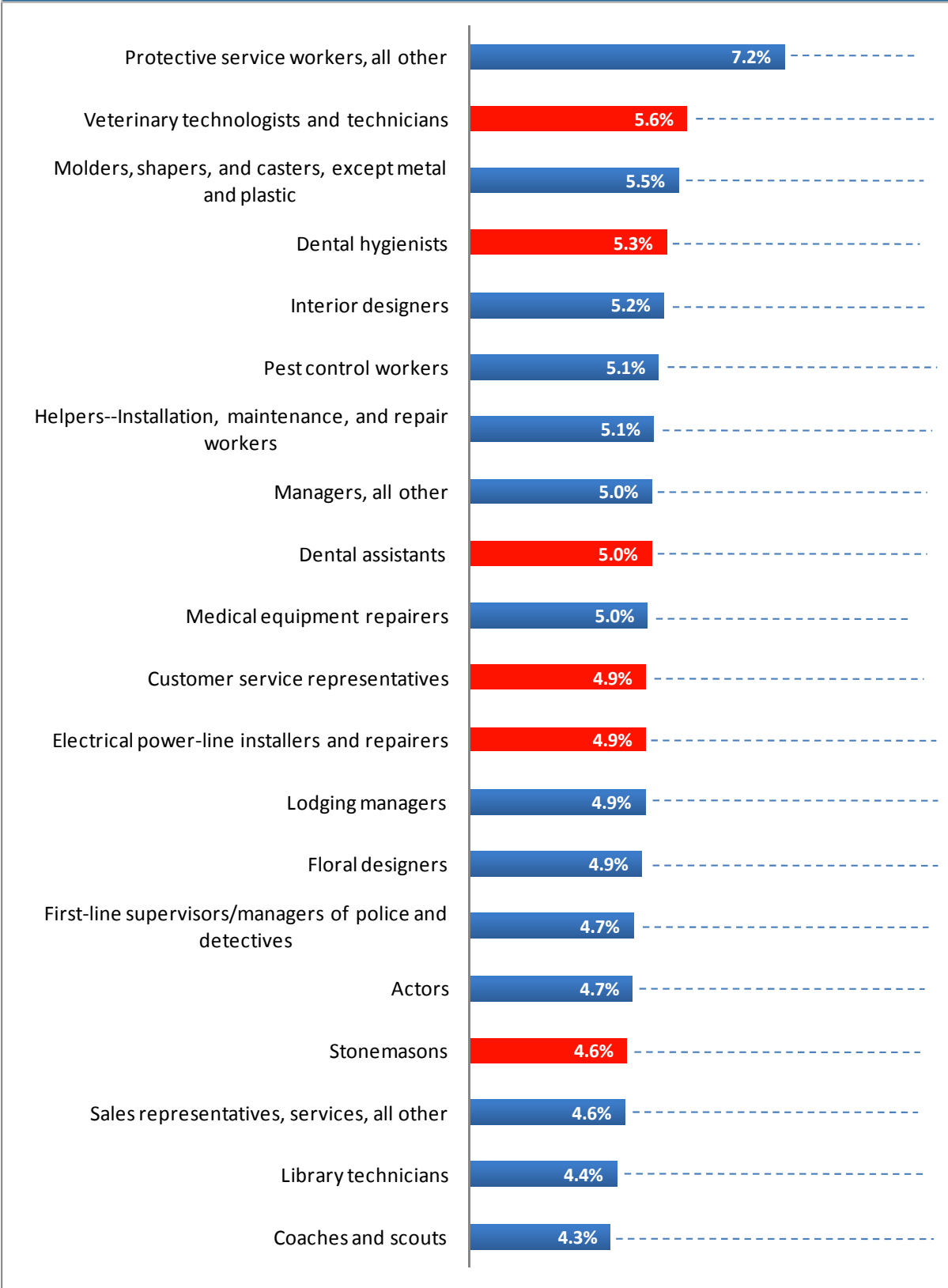

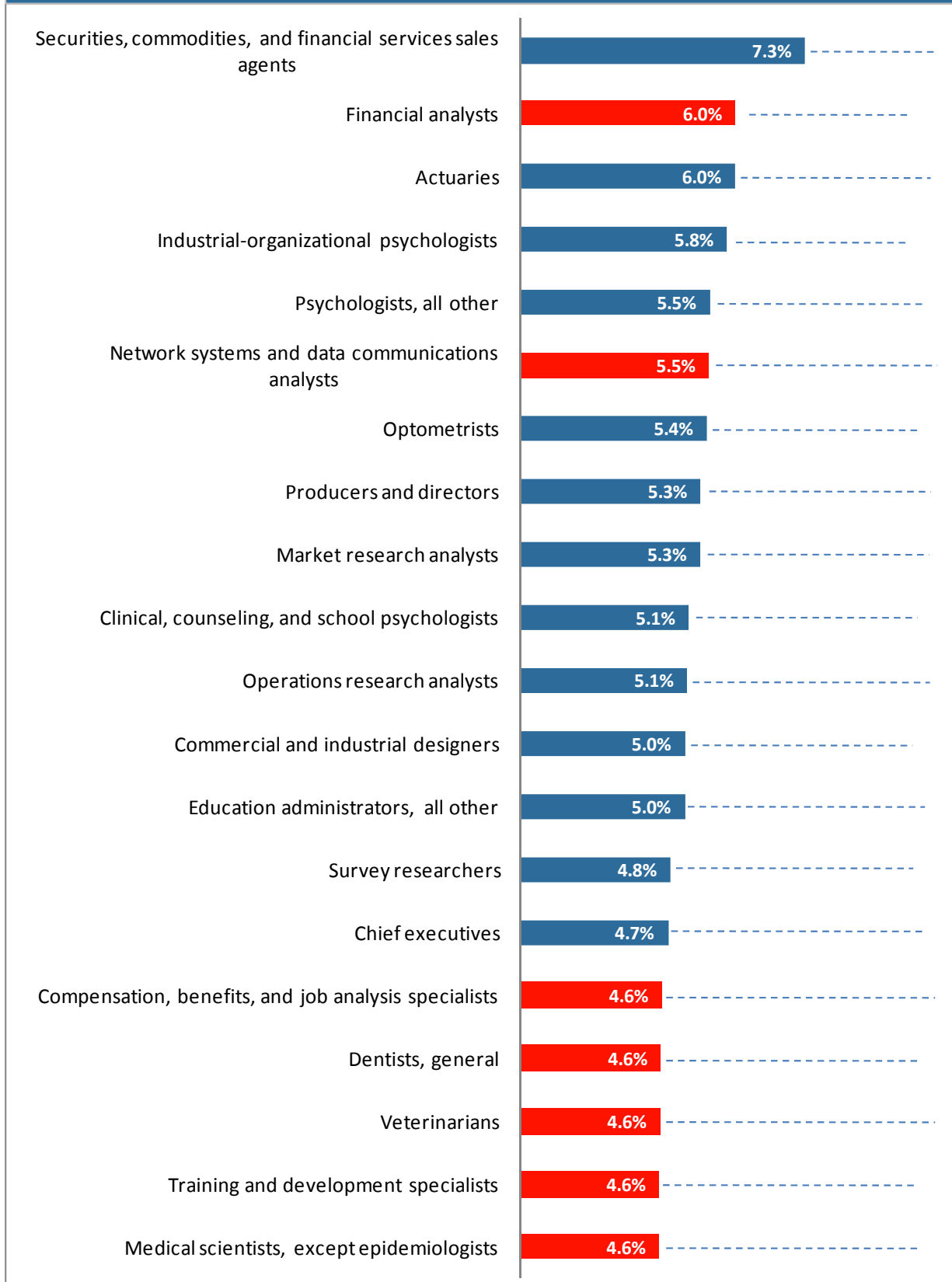
## Fastest Growing Occupations that Require Less than 4 Years of Postsecondary Education

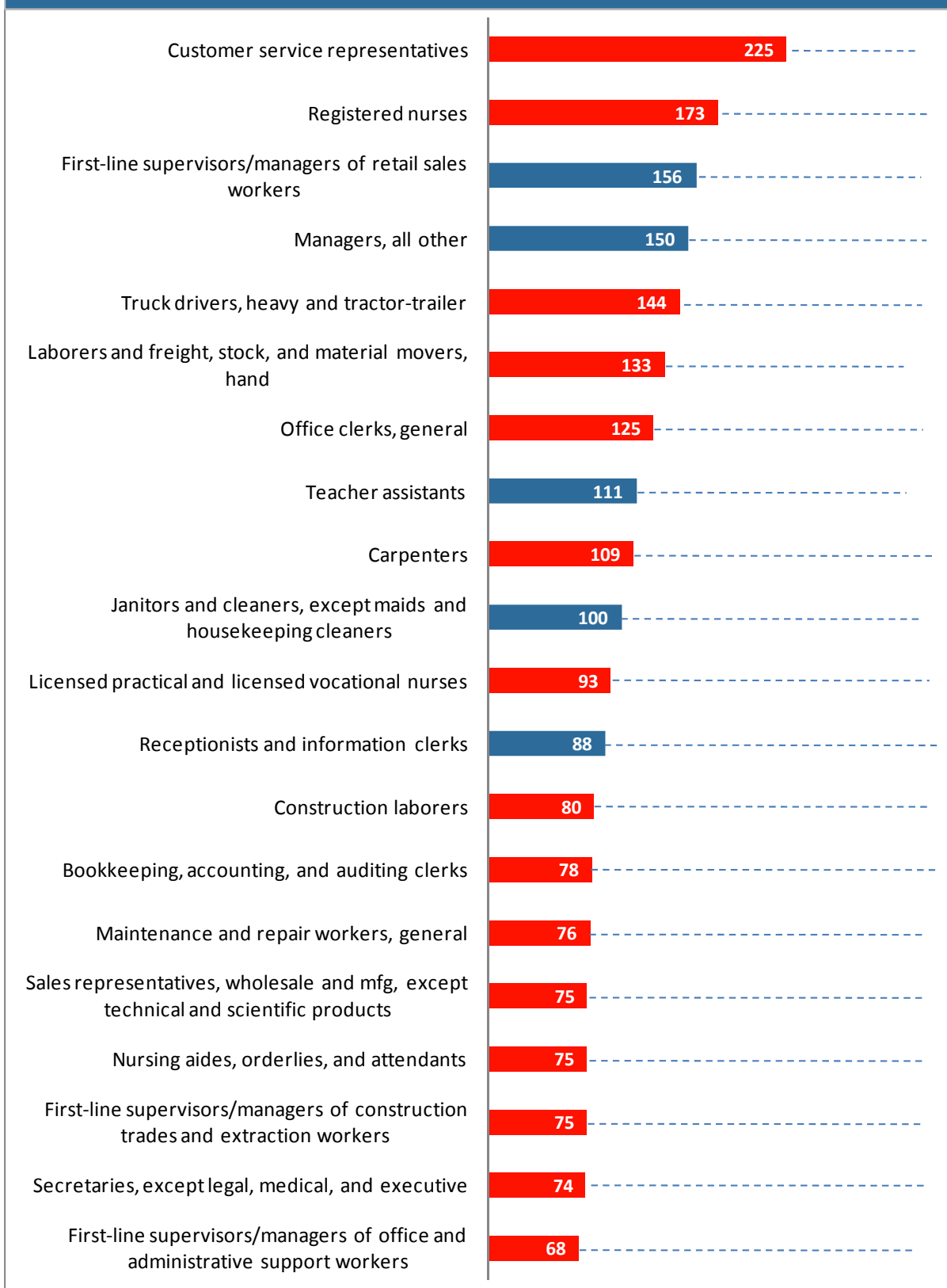
## Fastest Growing Occupations that Require a Bachelor's Degree or Higher

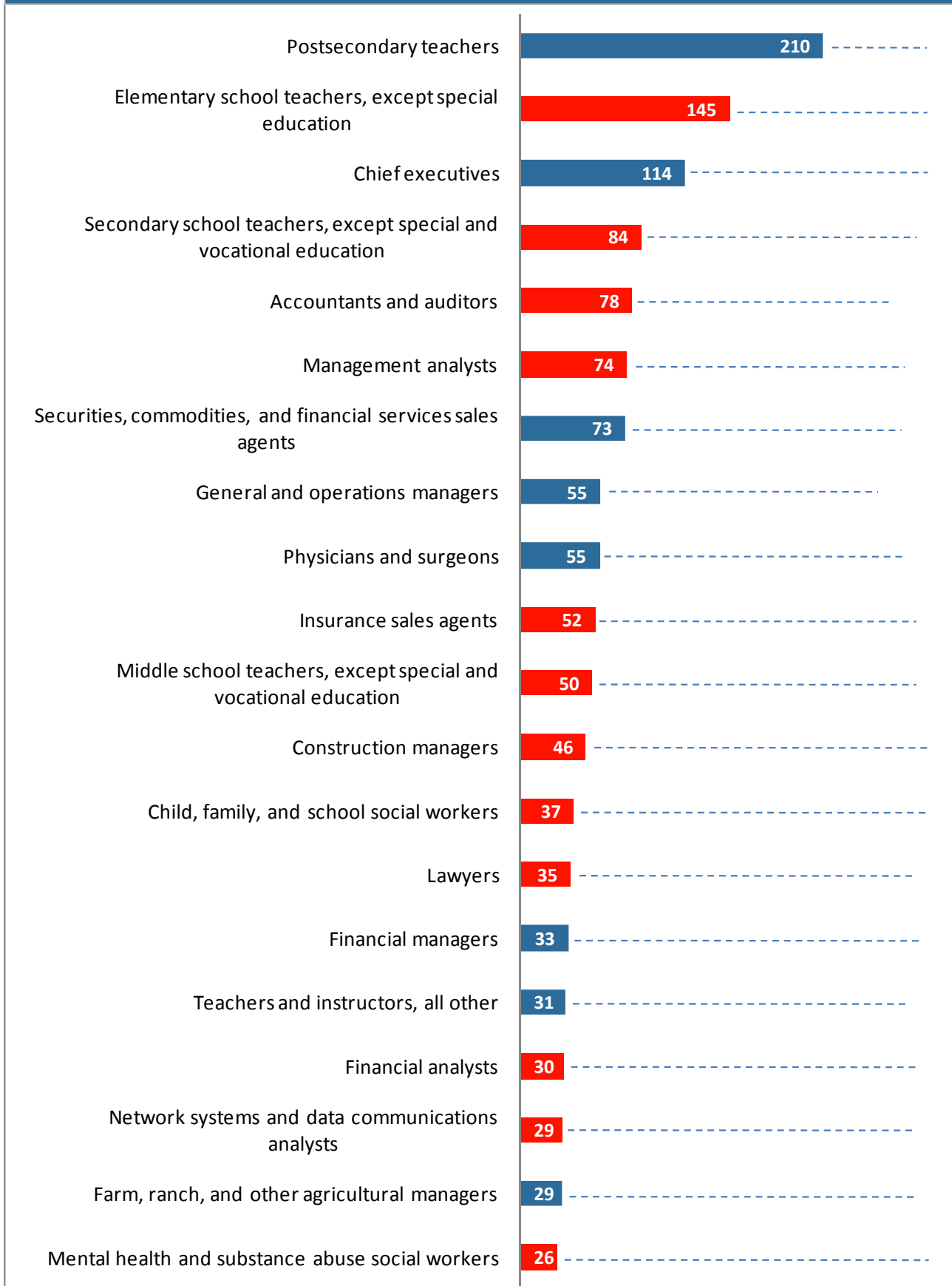
## Most Job Openings for Occupations that Require Less than 4 Years of Postsecondary Education
