United States

| | Labor Force | Employed | Unemployed | Unemployment Rate |

- **Long-Term Unemployed:** 1.243M, increase of 77,000 since last month (*unemployed for 27 weeks and over*)
- **U-6 Unemployment Rate:** 7.2% (*U-6: total unemployed (U-3) plus discouraged workers (U-4), plus all other marginally attached workers (U-5), plus total employed part time for economic reasons (U-6)*)
- **Job Openings:** 7.217M (*July 2019 preliminary*). This equates to 0.8 unemployed persons per job opening, or 1.6 persons using the U-6 Unemployment Rate.

Nonfarm jobs: 151.541M (85.1% private, 14.9% public)

- Monthly change: +130,000 (+96,000 private, +34,000 public)
- Largest industry growth: Professional and business services (+37,000), Federal, except U.S. Postal Service (+27,300), and Health care (+23,900)
- Average monthly job growth (total nonfarm jobs) since last year: +173,000
- Job change from 5 years ago: 12.269M more jobs

Initial Claims: 217,000

- Weekly change: +1,000
- Annual change: +7,000

Advance August 31 seasonally adjusted regular UC program data; U.S. Department of Labor

Initial Claims: The count of notices of unemployment requesting a determination of eligibility and entitlement for Unemployment Compensation (UC) benefits. A person can file multiple claims.

Unemployment Rate by Educational Attainment:

- Less than a high school diploma: 5.4%
- High school diploma: 3.6%
- Some College or Associate Degree: 3.1%
- Bachelor's degree and higher: 2.1%

As educational attainment levels increase, unemployment rates decrease.

- 34th lowest unemployment rate across the nation
- **Nonfarm Jobs:** 6.039M (88.2% private, 11.8% public; annual change: +0.5)
- **Regular UC Initial Claims:** 48,600 (annual change: -8.4%) (*May 2019*)
- **U-6 Unemployment Rate:** 8.0% (*BLS, 2018Q3 – 2019Q2*)
- **Online Job Postings:** 715,300 (*EMSI, July 2019*). This equates to 0.3 unemployed persons per online job posting, or 0.8 persons when considering the U-6 Unemployment Rate.

Central Pennsylvania

- **Online Job Postings:** 34,500 (*EMSI, July 2019*). This equates to 0.4 unemployed persons per online job posting, or 0.8 using an estimated U-6 unemployment rate of 8.8%.
