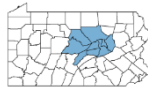

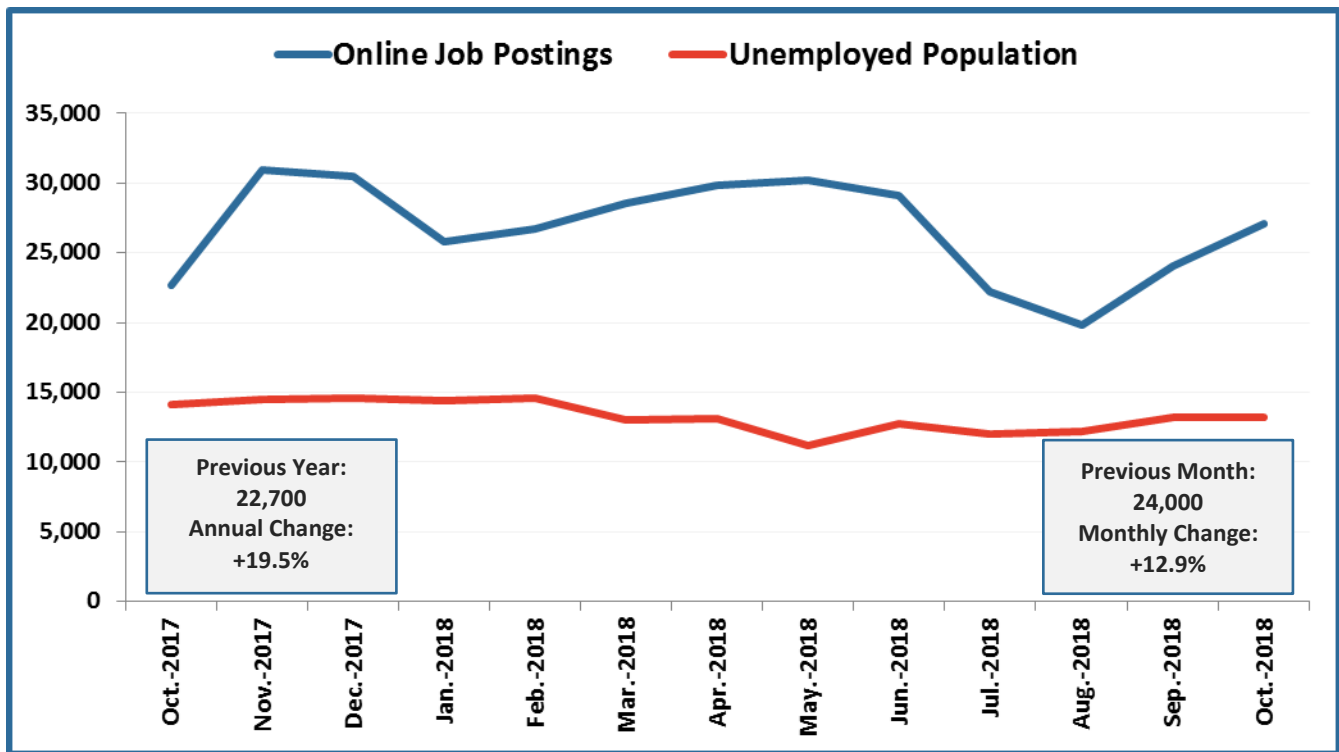

- Laborers and Freight, Stock, and Material Movers, Hand: \$13.09
- Light Truck or Delivery Services Drivers: \$12.52
- Postsecondary Teachers: \$35.74
- Registered Nurses: \$29.47
- Retail Salespersons: \$10.96
- Taxi Drivers and Chauffeurs: \$10.89
