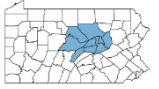


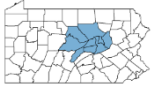

### NOTES:

- Data Source: EMSI, 2021.1
- Unless noted, information is based on 2020 estimates.
- Jobs include QCEW (Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages) jobs, Non-QCEW jobs, and Sole-Proprietors located in Central PA.
- Projected openings include new (businesses opening or expanding) and replacement (turnover) opportunities for the 2020-2023 time period.
- Median hourly occupational wages do not include benefits, but they do include commissions, incentive pay, and tips.
- Location quotients compare the concentration of employment locally to the State. A value of 1.0 or greater indicates a higher concentration, and a value less than 1.0 indicates a smaller concentration.
- Resident workers are individuals who live in Central PA and have jobs in the occupational grouping. Resident workers either work in Central PA (non-commuters), or they work in other regions (out-commuters).
- “Net commuters” compares local jobs to resident workers. If “net commuters” is positive, there are more local jobs than resident workers, meaning workers who live in other regions commute into Central PA (in-commuters) to fill all local jobs. If “net commuters” is negative, there are more resident workers than local jobs, meaning some resident workers who live in Central PA commute to other regions (out-commuters) for work.
- EMSI does not identify the residence county of in-commuters or the work county for out-commuters.
